

Deadhorse Camp Uniform Guidelines

Specific uniform requirements vary dependent upon the specific position being worked by a coworker. Coworkers are expected to arrive at work in a uniform that is clean and wrinkle-free. Professional appearance guidelines will be upheld both on- and off-stage while in the presence of camp guests.

Deadhorse Camp Provides:

Cook:	2 black cook pants & 2 t-shirts
Dishwasher/Prep:	2 black cook pants & 2 t-shirts
Server:	2 uniform shirts
Lodging Cleaner:	2 uniform shirts

Coworker Provides:

Cook:	black, professional shoes & black, grey or white undershirts
Dishwasher/Prep:	black, professional shoes & black, grey or white undershirts
Server:	black or tan pants & neutral color undershirts (no shorts)
Lodging Cleaner:	tan pants or shorts & neutral color undershirts

Professional Appearance Guidelines:

Women

Hair --- clean, well-groomed, not interfering with duties
No excessive or exotic color make-up
No facial, neck, or tongue tattoos or piercings
Ear piercings limited to two per ear
No neck jewelry or pins worn on outside of uniform
No excessive hand jewelry

Men

Hair --- clean, well-groomed, no longer than shoulder length
Beards --- clean, neat/closely trimmed, not exotic in appearance
No excessive or exotic color make-up
No ear, facial, neck, or tongue tattoos or piercings
No neck jewelry or pins worn on outside of uniform
No excessive hand jewelry
